CAG Meeting #2 Summary | March 22, 2017



The second Community Advisory Group (CAG) meeting for IL 43 between 63rd Street and 65th Street was held on Wednesday, March 22, 2017 at the Bedford Park Public Library at 7816 W 65th PI, Summit, IL 60501 from 10:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m.

To announce the second CAG meeting, an email invitation and postcards were sent to additional individuals who showed interest in participating in the CAG and those who attended the first CAG meeting. The website was also updated to reflect the second CAG meeting date and confirmation phone calls were conducted. Twenty-seven CAG members attended the meeting.

Facilitated Discussion and Group Exercises

The CAG was asked to list what a successful outcome for this project would look like.

In small groups, the CAG was able to discuss and write out the project goals on an easel pad. Each group was then asked to read their project goals aloud.

The next group exercise allowed the CAG to draw different types of minor and major improvements that would meet the project goals identified in the first exercise. The CAG worked in small groups to sketch alternatives on a large roll plot map.



Project Goals for IL 43 between 63rd and 65th Streets



Improve emergency response



Relieve drainage and flooding issues



Reduce traffic through residential areas



Improve safety and access for pedestrian and cyclists



Improve traffic flow on Harlem at 63rd and Harlem at 65th



Improve congestion delays

The Project Study Group (PSG) will review and consider the input from the group exercises when developing preliminary alternatives. The next CAG meeting will present concepts of alternatives and the final Purpose and Need statement.
